OUR MISSION



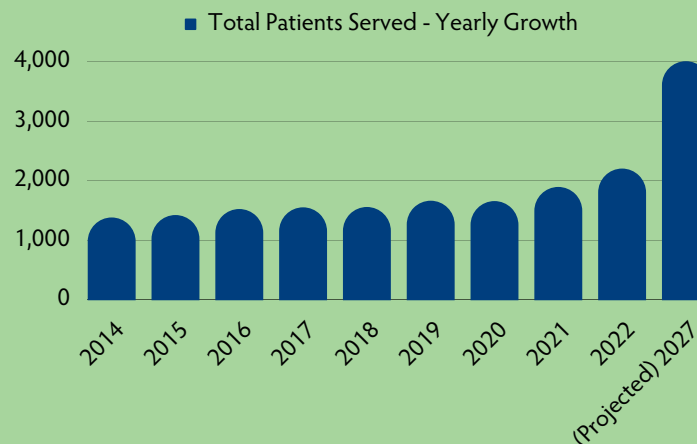
Circle of Life is committed to providing compassionate end-of-life care for a person's body, mind, spirit and family when there is no longer a cure.

At Circle of Life, we operate at the highest level of service. We are innovative and set standards that raise the bar, always doing the right thing for the right reasons. Our team is committed to providing Northwest Arkansas with the best end-of-life care.

We provide hospice care in our patient's homes, nursing homes, long-term care facilities, and our two hospice homes in Bentonville and Springdale. However, 93% of our patients choose to live safely and comfortably in their homes while receiving hospice care. Helping people live their lives in dignity and comfort in their homes is our core service.



In 2021, Circle of Life served approximately 2,000 patients and their families in Benton, Carroll, Madison, and Washington counties. Data shows that we will double that number over the next ten years. A majority of that growth will be in our outpatient services. As our region grows, so does the need for end-of-life care.



OUR VISION + FUTURE

As we continue to grow, we have an essential need for a new building to be the hub for our outpatient care coordination. Our existing outpatient facility cannot accommodate our growing staff and the additional medical equipment needed for the increasing number of patients.

To meet our growing needs, Circle of Life has purchased nine acres of land at the corner of Goad Springs Road and Metro Plaza in Lowell. This new hub will be the heart of our operations and the home base for our outpatient care team. Physicians, nurses, certified nursing assistants, social workers, chaplains, and volunteers will have dedicated work and meeting spaces, training rooms, and a warehouse for medical equipment provided to patients in their homes. This new facility will give our hospice team the best environment to collaborate and provide patient-centered healthcare to our community.

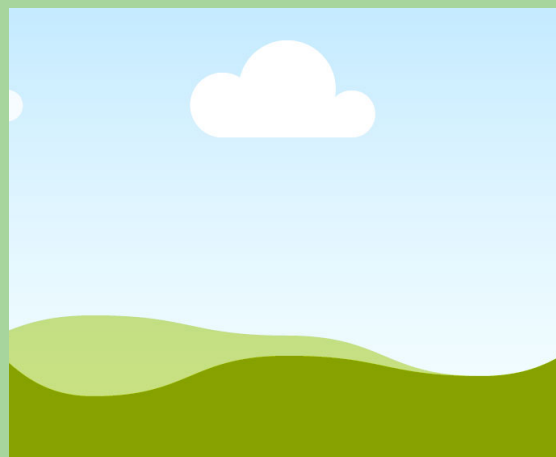

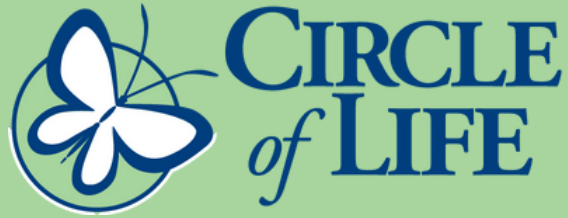
OUTPATIENT SERVICES BUILDING
