We have to turn away those seeking private and reserves spaces every year due to lack of space. Our numerous programs, meetings, interviews, and tutoring sessions take place in the open, serving as a distraction to others in the library. We must enhance the Napoleon Public Library to meet and support the community's growing needs.

OUR VISION



To serve our community's expectations, we are proposing the renovation and expansion of our beautiful and historic Carnegie Library. This project will allow us to better serve our patrons, employees, businesses and organizations. The renovation will include a new ADA compliant wing, private conference/program room, private tutor rooms, updated local history genealogy and research area and a user-friendly drive-up book return.

The proposed renovation and addition will more than double our library's current square footage in order to provide a true community-focused facility.

Not only will the project improve the library's scope of services, it will also contribute to Napoleon's downtown revitalization by breathing new life into a historic building.

The renovations will transform the library into an accessible, convenient meeting space for individuals and groups alike.

PROJECT DETAILS CONNECTING WING


The need is great, as there are currently no areas for staff to greet patrons and visitors entering the library.



The new connecting wing will offer a point of service, enabling staff to greet visitors, answer questions, and point patrons in the proper direction. An established entrance will improve safety and security, as well as provide a comfortable, accessible connector between the two buildings for visitors of all ages.
